- Q. Pertussis-what are we looking for in the lab work?
- A. https://epi.dph.ncdhhs.gov/cd/lhds/manuals/cd/pertussis.html
- Q. The meeting time change is not recurring, is it?

- Q. I have IgG and IgM +
- A. Confirmatory laboratory evidence:
 - Isolation of B. pertussis from a clinical specimen
 - Positive Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) for B. pertussis
- Q. Isolation of B. pertussis from a clinical specimen implies serology.
- **A.** Isolation of B. pertussis from a clinical specimen is a bacterial culture and is a different assay than a serology which looks for antibodies in the blood.
