Steps of an Outbreak Investigation





- **North Carolina Communicable Disease Branch**
 - 1. Identify investigation team and resources
 - 2. Establish the existence of an outbreak
 - 3. Verify the diagnosis
 - 4. Construct a working case definition
 - 5. Case finding: Find cases systematically and develop line list
 - 6. Perform descriptive epidemiology and develop hypotheses
 - 7. Evaluate hypotheses and perform additional studies (as necessary)
 - 8. Implement control measures
 - 9. Communicate findings
- 10. Maintain surveillance
