

## Quick Reference: Preventing and Handling Duplicate Monitoring Events

Scenario	Actions	Determine if the individual...	Next Steps
<b>CASE INVESTIGATOR: Preventing duplication before entering a contact monitoring event</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Search the “All Monitoring Events” view by key pieces of information, such as last name, phone number, email, or mailing address.</li> <li>Open each result and check for matching info.</li> </ol>	...has an existing <b>active</b> monitoring event:	<b>ACTION:</b> Speak with the contact’s owner and update the existing active monitoring event as needed.
		...existing <b>inactive</b> monitoring event:	<b>ACTION:</b> Proceed with creating a new monitoring event from this individual’s person record per p. 6 of the <a href="#">Person Job Aid</a> .
		...is a <b>new individual</b> who has never been monitored in the Tool:	<b>ACTION:</b> Create a new monitoring event.
<b>CASE INVESTIGATOR: Duplicate warning while entering a contact monitoring event</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Right-click on each linked entry and select “Open link in new tab.”</li> <li>Review each monitoring event.</li> </ol>	...has an existing <b>active</b> monitoring event:	<b>ACTION:</b> DO NOT SAVE. Speak with the contact’s owner and update the existing active monitoring event as needed.
		...existing <b>inactive</b> monitoring event:	<b>ACTION:</b> DO NOT SAVE. Proceed with creating a new monitoring event from this individual’s person record per p. 6 of the <a href="#">Person Job Aid</a> .
		...is a <b>new individual</b> who has never been monitored in the Tool:	<b>ACTION:</b> Click “Ignore and Save.”
<b>CONTACT TRACER: Duplicate warning on existing contact monitoring event</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Right-click on each linked entry and select “Open link in new tab.”</li> <li>Review each monitoring event.</li> </ol>	...has a <b>duplicate, active ME that is currently being monitored:</b>	<b>ACTION:</b> Proceed to the process on page 2 of the <a href="#">Handling Duplicates Job Aid</a> .
		...is a previously-monitored contact with a <b>deactivated monitoring event under a different person record (P#):</b>	<b>ACTION:</b> Remove and replace the incorrect person record in the “Person” field per p. 6 of the <a href="#">Person Job Aid</a> .
		...is not a duplicate and is a <b>new individual</b> who has never been monitored before in the Tool:	<b>ACTION:</b> Continue with monitoring this individual.

***Remember that you should never deactivate or delete another user’s contact unless explicitly instructed to do so.***
