


Disabling Autofill in your Browser

ALWAYS disable/turn off the autofill/auto complete in the internet browser that you use to access NC COVID and/or NCEDSS. Overwriting of data fields can occur if this feature is not disabled. Google Chrome or Firefox are preferred browsers.


Google Chrome



- Click on the Customize and control menu (the 3 dots) at the top right of the browser window




- Select Settings




- A new screen tab open, click on the main menu (the 3 lines) to the left of Settings at the top left of the screen

- Select Autofill
 - A new tab will open with the Autofill options



- Click on Passwords and toggle off all options
 - Click on Check passwords to ensure there are no saved passwords


- Click on the arrow to the left of each category to return to the previous menu



Disabling Autofill





Google Chrome, con't



- Click on Addresses and more and toggle off all options
 - If you have any saved addresses, delete them
- Click on the arrow to the left of each category to return to the previous menu

Firefox



- Click on the Open Application Menu (the 3 lines) at the top right of your browser window
- Select Settings
- Click on Privacy & Security on the left
 - The Browser Privacy options will appear on the right
 - You will need to scroll to get to the sections you need to update
- Logins and Passwords
 - Unselect all check boxes
 - Click the Saved Logins button and delete all, if any exists
- Forms and Autofill
 - Unselect all check boxes
 - Click the Saved Addresses button and delete all, if any exist
 - Click the Saved Credit Cards button and delete all, if any exist
