Chest pain









Headache

Shortness of breath

Nausea or

If you feel you may have any signs or symptoms OR

your CO alarm or CO detector sounds,

STEP 1: Get vourself and others outdoors to an area with clean air immediately.

STEP 2: (ALL 911!

STEP 3: Do NOT drive a motor vehicle.

STEP 4: Stay away from the area until it is determined to be safe.
