



This deposit is located on the west side of the Whitewater River, 5.0 miles southeast of Cashiers. It can be reached by traveling on State Highway 107 for 5.9 miles southeast of its intersection with U.S. Highway 64 to SR 1103. Turn east on 1103 and travel 0.6 mile to where SR 1103 ends. At this point an abandoned logging road leads northeast to the river, a distance of about 0.5 mile. The mine is located about 1000 feet west-southwest of the Jennings No. 1 mine.
